

Welcome to the second trimester -

I am changing the homework routine a bit for the next month or so - In addition to reading a little every night (the next book reports are due Dec. 2!) weekly homework is as follows:

Math Logs; they go home on Monday and are due the following Monday

- I expect students to practice multiplication and addition facts for at least 10 minutes 5 of the 7 nights of the week
- The students may practice their math facts however they would like....games, workbooks, verbally in the car, etc.
  - Turned in on Monday = 10 pts (full credit)
  - Tuesday, 1 day late = 8 pts
  - Wednesday, 2 days late = 6 pts
  - Thursday, 3 days late = 4 pts
  - Friday, 4 days late = 2 points
  - if the log is over a week late it will not be given credit

- This is not really an assignment that can be made up, math a subject that must be practiced regularly so I will not accept late assignments as I have in the past.

Spelling Tic Tac Toe; they go home on Monday and are due that Friday

- I expect students to do one activity a night, not to do all three in one night - I understand this may not work with everyone's schedule of extra-curriculars.
- They are due at the end of the week on Friday
  - Turned in on Friday = 10 pts (full credit)
  - Monday, 1 day late = 8 pts
  - Tuesday, 2 days late = 6 pts
  - Wednesday, 3 days late = 4 pts
  - Thursday, 4 days late = 2 pts
  - if the log is over a week late it will not be given credit

- This is not really an assignment that can be made up, we move on to a new set of words each week so I will not accept late assignments as I have in the past.

Both assignment sheets are available on the website under the documents section. I will accept handwritten math logs on scratch paper in addition to an email letting me know your student has practiced 5 of the 7 nights in the week. For spelling, I will also accept an email letting me know your student did some of the activities at home.
